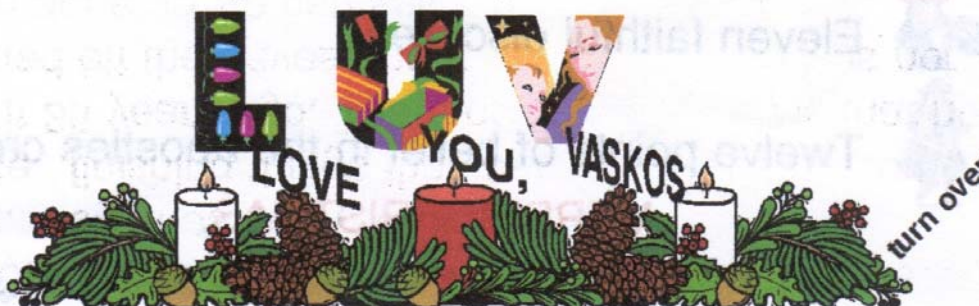
JJ is still in Santiago, Chile, for another year. He did invite us for Christmas, but it's a very long flight.
